Peter said to Jesus, “Lord, it is good for us to be here. If You wish,
I will put up three shelters – one for You ... While he was still speaking,
a bright cloud covered them, and a voice from the cloud said, “*This is
My Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased. Listen to Him!*” (4-5)
