

# The Church in The Last Days

the apostle Paul's first letter to Timothy / 5:17-25

The Church in The Last Days follows the lessons for \_\_\_\_\_.

What are the Biblical lessons for leadership in the local church?

1. The lesson for leadership and \_\_\_\_\_.

The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are *worthy of double honor*, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching. (17)

For Scripture says, "Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain," and "The worker deserves his wages." (18)

2. The lesson for leadership and \_\_\_\_\_.

Do not entertain *an accusation against an elder* unless it is brought by two or three witnesses. (19)

But those elders who are sinning you are to reprove before everyone, so that the others may take warning. (20)

3. The lesson for leadership and \_\_\_\_\_.

I charge you, in the sight of God and Christ Jesus and the elect angels, to *keep these instructions without partiality*, and to do nothing out of favoritism. (21)

4. The lesson for leadership and \_\_\_\_\_.

*Do not be hasty in the laying on of hands*, and do not share in the sins of others. Keep yourself pure. (22)

5. The lesson for leadership and \_\_\_\_\_.

Stop drinking *only water*, use a little wine because of your stomach and your frequent illness. (23)

6. The lesson for leadership and \_\_\_\_\_.

The sins of some are obvious, reaching the place of judgment ahead of them; the sins of others trail behind them. (24)

In the same way, *good deeds are obvious*, and even those that are not obvious cannot remain hidden forever. (25)

*Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority*, because they keep watch over you as those who must give an account.

Do this so that their work will be a \_\_\_\_\_,  
not a burden, for that would be of no benefit to you. (Hebrews 13:17)
